Romans 10:1 (NASB)

¹ Brethren, my heart's desire and my prayer to God for them is for *their* salvation.

- **Brethren:** term of endearment
- **Desire:** a strong feeling for something to happen
- **Prayer:** a solemn request for help or expression of thanks addressed to God or an object or worship
- **Salvation:** to heal, preserve, rescue
- *Everything is focused on an outward expression*

John 10:10 (NASB)

¹⁰ "The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I came that they may have life, and have *it* abundantly.

Thief: a person who steals another person's property, especially by stealth and without using force or violence

Stealth: cautious and surreptitious action or movement

Steal: to take thru deception

Kill: to murder, commit intentional unjustified homicide

Destroy: the resultant death being viewed as certain

Romans 10:1 (NASB)

¹ Brethren, my heart's desire and my prayer to God for them is for *their* salvation.

- Satan comes to steal, kill and destroy
- Christ comes to give life and give it abundantly
- Salvation: is the opposite of everything satan wants to do.....salvation provides healing, it preserves, it provides rescue

Ephesians 3:20-21 (NASB)

²⁰ Now to Him who is able to do far more abundantly beyond all that we ask or think, according to the power that works within us, ²¹ to Him *be* the glory in the church and in Christ Jesus to all generations forever and ever. Amen.

John 14:6 (NASB)

⁶ Jesus *said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.

Without God there can be no abundant life and without Christ there is no access to the Father, salvation is a must and it should be our hearts desire that everyone would be saved.

Romans 10:2 (NASB)

² For I testify about them that they have a zeal for God, but not in accordance with knowledge.

Testify: to provide evidence

Zealous: enthusiasm, jealousy, onomatopoeic term that mimics a sound, the formation of a word like meow, honk, boom, by imitation of a sound the word is formed.

Knowledge: functional working knowledge gleaned from first-hand personal experience, connecting theory to application

The number of Christians around the world has nearly quadrupled in the last 100 years, from about 6 million in 1910 to more than 2 billion in 2010. But the world's overall population also has risen rapidly, from an estimated 1.8 billion in 1910 to 6.9 billion in 2010. As a result, Christians make up about the same portion of the world's population today [32%] as they did a century ago [35%].

Lifeway Research Survey

64% God accepts the worship of all religions, including Christianity, Judaism, and Islam.

52% seeing good deeds as a way to reach heaven.

40% said those who reject or don't believe in Jesus will be sent to hell, what happened to the other 60%?

52% said Bible, alone, is the written word of God.

61% believe Jesus is human & divine.

28% see the Holy Spirit as a divine being that isn't equal to God.

43% believe the Bible is not accurate.

51% said the Bible was written to allow each individual to interpret as he or she chooses.

Romans 10:3 (NASB)

³ For not knowing about God's righteousness and seeking to establish their own, they did not subject themselves to the righteousness of God.

Righteousness: the state of him who is such as he ought to be, the condition acceptable to God

John 14:6 (NASB)

*⁶ Jesus *said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.*

The worlds definition of righteousness will send them straight to hell.

Romans 10:4 (NASB95)

4 For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone who believes.

- Jesus Christ is the culmination of the law.
- OT to get to God one needed a High Priest who would make the sacrificial offering.
- NT Jesus Christ was the final sacrificial offering and our High Priest.

Romans 10:5–7 (NASB95)

5 For Moses writes that the man who practices the righteousness which is based on law shall live by that righteousness. 6 But the righteousness based on faith speaks as follows: “DO NOT SAY IN YOUR HEART, ‘WHO WILL ASCEND INTO HEAVEN?’ (that is, to bring Christ down), 7 or ‘WHO WILL DESCEND INTO THE ABYSS?’ (that is, to bring Christ up from the dead).”

Romans 10:8 (NASB95)

8 But what does it say? “THE WORD IS NEAR YOU, IN YOUR MOUTH AND IN YOUR HEART”—that is, the word of faith which we are preaching,



The works of the cross are completed, He was crucified, died, buried, but on the third day He rose from the dead and all that Adam gave away, Jesus took back and He has risen just as He said!!!!!!

Romans 10:9–10 (NASB95)

9 that if you confess with your mouth Jesus *as* Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved; 10 for with the heart a person believes, resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth he confesses, resulting in salvation.

If I confess with my mouth that
Jesus is Lord, believe that God
raised Him from the dead.....



Romans 10:9–10 (NASB95)
