New Year's Emptying ~ What God Wants from Us for 2013 Psalm 39:1-7

Review: How are we doing with our assignment of daily solitude? <u>Definition of Biblical Courage</u>: A supernaturally <u>INDUCED</u> strength that empowers the Believer to consistently do God's will.

"Let us go right into the presence of God with sincere hearts fully trusting Him." ~ Hebrews 10:22 (easier said than done).

<u>Introduction</u>: God wants us to draw closer, but are we willing?

- Our Big "God" Problem: Keeping a <u>SAFE</u> distance, (but with the best intentions).
- I. What God wants Relationally from us in 2013:
 - He wants it to be REAL. But how?
 - Psalm 39's problem: TURMOIL. vs. 2
 - Psalm 39's solution: <u>SETTLE</u> with reality. vs. 7
- II. More from Psalm 39 on the issue:

We give ourselves a lot of <u>CREDIT</u>.

Example: I will not <u>SIN</u>.

Outcome: He got angrier and angrier!

We need reminders about our MORTALITY.

Example: Life is **SHORT**. vss. 4,5

Outcome: Most of it is WASTED. vs.6
