

## TRINITY LUTHERAN PRESCHOOL



In February, Mrs. Wilson's classes enjoyed a month-long pet theme. Students enjoyed learning about different pets and how to care for them and had the opportunity to bring their pets from home to share. We met many interesting pets, including several breeds of dogs, some guinea pigs, a goat, and a chicken. Our dramatic play area was devoted to our Preschool Pet Shop where students pretended to buy and sell and care for different pets, and our three-year-old classes visited a real pet store. Some of our favorite books about pets were <a href="Harry the Dirty Dog">Harry the Dirty Dog</a> by Gene Zion, <a href="Dear Zoo">Dear Zoo</a> by Rod Campbell, and <a href="Cookie's Week">Cookie's Week</a> by Cindy Ward. Four-year-old classes also learned about healthy eating and food groups and had a fun restaurant day in class and took a trip to New Seasons Market. All classes enjoyed Valentine's Day activities and parties, and learned about our Bible verse, "Love the Lord your God with all your heart". We learned what that means through Bible stories about people who followed God even when it was not easy, such as Daniel being thrown to the lions for praying to God, and Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego who chose to be thrown into a furnace rather than bow down to a statue. In March we heard the story of St. Patrick and learned that Jesus is our Shepherd through the story of the Lost Sheep and read the story of the real meaning of Easter. We are looking forward to some fun outdoor themes and activities once we return from Spring break.
