Here are a few key truths that relate to Life Groups: 1) *You can't grow spiritually without connecting relationally. Circles are better than rows.* 2) a way of continuously re-centering our heart on Jesus and His Word, 3) an opportunity to hear the voice of Jesus and respond to the leading of His Spirit, 4) through our Life Group, we often catch a glimpse of the Kingdom of God, and 5) we learn, in the nitty gritty of life, what it means to Join Jesus on His Mission. >>>

- Life Groups are leader breeders – safe, non-threatening environment for spiritual gifts to flourish.

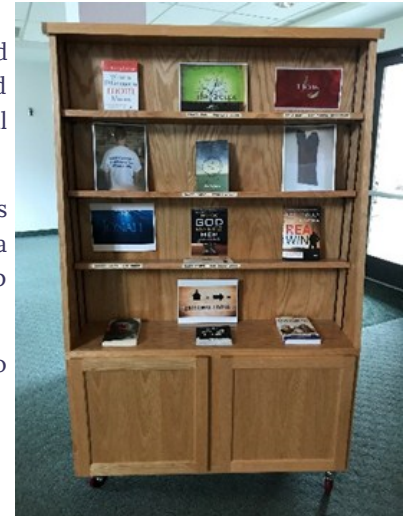
As with anything alive and breathing, Life Groups are always experiencing the ebb and flow with the changing seasons. Check with the group that interests you to see what’s their present schedule.

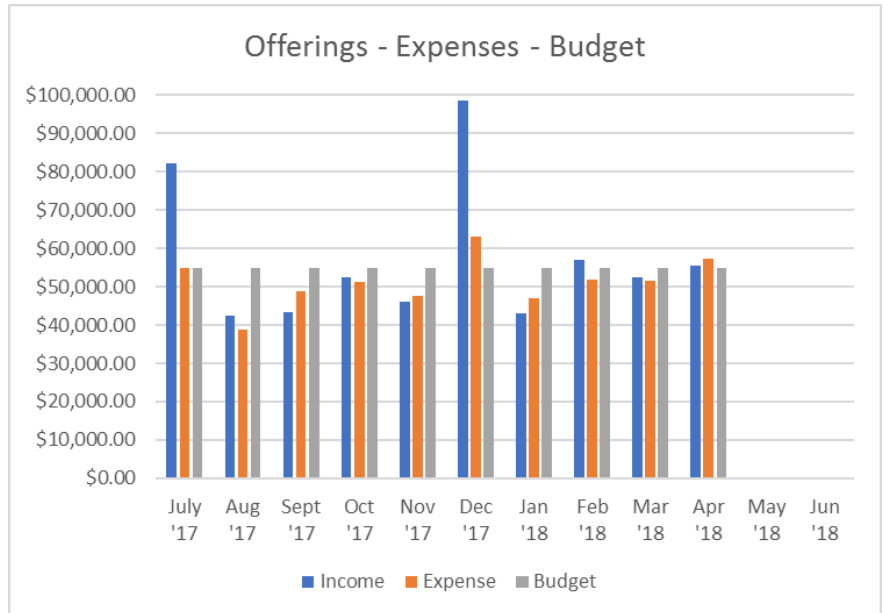

The children were curious about the lifecycle of tadpole to frog and why bugs were swimming in the water. It was fun and educational for us to watch the tadpoles we caught change into frogs. The beauty of Trinity's trees also displayed spring changes and new life. This transitioned well into talking about the new life we receive through Jesus' death and resurrection. In May we had two police officers come to school to talk safety and show us their police car. We ended this unit with our St. Jude trike-a-thon where the children rode their bikes at school.
