Every three years the LCMS holds a national convention; the next one is scheduled for July 2019. In preparation for the national event, districts hold their conventions the proceeding year. The Northwest District's Convention is set for 21-23 June 2018 in Portland. At our recent congregational meeting I was designated as our Lay Delegate and I plan to attend the entire event next summer and represent Trinity.
