As we experience these times of rest and refreshment Jesus can bring peace to our souls, and we can be strengthened for serving him in our daily lives.


As we trust in Jesus, may we hear his invitation to come apart with him and rest awhile.

#### First Evangelical Lutheran Church Oakland, Nebraska

The church council met June 5, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. In attendance were Greg Johnson, Carole Johnson, Karl Lundquist, Sandy Husar, Nathan Anderson, Sam Schmidt and Mona Tanksley. Also in attendance was Pastor Eldal. Devotions were given by Pastor Eldal. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved. Pastor presented his report for May discussing activities that occurred during the month.

<u>The Treasurer's report</u> was reviewed and it was noted on the Profit and Loss statement that through May the income exceeded expenses by \$1,338.72, through the month of May showed a loss of \$2,791.51.

It was reported that the Bible school decorations were given to another organization for their use.

<u>Old Business:</u> Greg reported that the furnace and air conditioners have been installed. There was discussion about the Spire newsletter being emailed to members versus mailing it and taking advantage of the bulk mail rate. We will continue to check out the options. Greg also reported that the van will be taken to Blanc's Body Shop for external body work.

The Property Committee reported on a problem with a downspout by the ramp where dirt has settled letting some rain water get into the basement. Work will be done to fill in this area to hopefully solve the problem. There was discussion about ways to make the balcony cooler in the summer, i.e. installing ceiling fans. No decision was made. However, we will look into possible solutions. The coverings on the window wells were again discussed with the decision made to leave them as is for now. A bid has been received from Bryson Peterson for stucco repair and painting on the exterior southeast part of the building. After much discussion, a motion was made by Sandy, seconded by Karl to approve \$4,600 for the painting and to allow additional money for rental of lift equipment not to exceed \$7,500 for the entire project. Motion carried. Nathan agreed to contact Bryson regarding the cost of the rental equipment. Dr. Charles Seagren has offered to donate two framed pictures to the church. The council agreed to accept them and thank him for his gift.

<u>The Evangelism Committee</u> reported that Vacation Bible School went very well with about 70 attending. The committee is working on a schedule listing all youth activities.

The next meeting will be June 26 at 7:00 p.m.




