
As we trust in Jesus, may we take advantage of these opportunities, and be blessed in so doing.

The church council met January 2, 2017 at

7:00 p.m. In attendance were Greg Johnson, Carole Johnson, Carl Magnusson, Tom Meyer, Sandy Husar, Rachel Wise, Jim Pelan, Karl Lundquist, Jon Seagren and Mona Tanksley. Also in attendance was Pastor Eldal. After devotions were led by Sandy Husar, the minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Pastor presented his report for December after which there was a discussion about changing the time of the late service on Christmas eve to 9:00 pm instead of 10:00 p.m. This will be discussed again later in the year. The youth pizza was held the fourth Thursday of the month and nearly 100 students attended.

The treasurer's report was reviewed noting we have come close to meeting our expenses for the year. There is still at least one outstanding bill.

Jim Pelan expressed his thanks for allowing the service for Muriel Rabe to be held at our church.

<u>Old Business:</u> Jon Seagren reported on the progress of the remodeling project of the Sunday school room and noted that plans are to have the youth help with painting the room this Wednesday night. Greg Johnson reported on the status of the furnace/air conditioner installation noting that the installation will done as soon as we get a few days of warmer weather. He also reported that Clay Olson came and solved the problem with the furnace recently when it was not working. Greg read a letter he had drafted to Betty Starr requesting funds from her foundation.

New Business: Property Committee: Jim Pelan presented an update on a proposal to repair the sign on the west side of the church. The price of \$1450 was quoted if we install the sign ourselves and the cost for the company to install it was \$2250. The property committee reported that the new door in the southwest entrance to the basement has been installed and a little trim work remains to be done. We are awaiting a bid from Larry Shelly for some painting on the southeast part of the church. There was a discussion about finding ways to decrease the glare on the video screen when it is used. Ideas considered are installation of some shades or replacing the screen with a television set. More research will be done regarding the options available. It was noted that the large coffee pot is not working and we will look into this. It was also noted that we now have three ping pong tables downstairs and one is broken. We will look into repairing this and possibly disposing of one. Greg plans to announce at the annual meeting that we will be having a cleaning day at church and would like to have a representative from each organization present to make decisions on what needs to be kept and what can be disposed of.

The Evangelism Committee reported that a praise service is planned for Jan 8 and for the 15th as there will not be a contemporary service that day. Coffee will be available for members at the beginning of the service. The committee met today and they reported they have been using Facebook to post items. Anyone interested in being part of the Evangelism Committee is welcome to joint.

The annual meeting will be January 22 immediately following the worship service. The nominating committee has a slate of candidates to be elected to the council and outreach committee. Annual reports are due to be in by January 6. The budget and finance committee consisting of Carl, Jon and Sam, will meet in the near future to prepare the 2017 budget. If we know of any expenditures that will be increasing we are to let Carl or Jon know. The council will then plan to meet to review this budget after the Sunday service. There was discussion about possibly lowering the number of a quorum at the annual

meeting due to low attendance at previous meetings. The Christmas decorations will be taken down Saturday beginning at 9:00 a.m. Pastor reported that he will be on vacation January 31-February 7. The next meeting will be after the annual meeting on January 22 and there will be no February meeting.

First Evangelical Lutheran Church Oakland, Nebraska Annual Meeting January 22, 2017



The annual meeting of the congregation of First Evangelical Lutheran Church was held January 22, 2017. A quorum was met with 71 members present.

President Greg Johnson called the meeting to order at 10:40 am and Pastor Eldal led us in devotions. Council members present at the meeting in addition to Greg Johnson were Carole Johnson, Jim Pelan, Carl Magnusson, Cheryl Denker, Rachel Wise, Jon Seagren, Tom Meyer, Mona Tanksley, Karl Lundquist and Sandy Husar.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read, correcting the name of Jan Wiltse, and a motion was made by Darrell Denker to approve them. Motion seconded by Jon Seagren and carried.

The report of the Nominating Committee was given by Darrell Denker who reported that there are four nominees on the ballot for council positions with four to be elected. They are Jon Seagren, Susan Mulder, Linda Jones and Nathan Anderson. He also reported that Rick Mulder has agreed to serve on the Outreach Committee again. As there were no nominations from the floor for council or Outreach Committee positions, a motion was made by Charlie Seagren that nominations cease and we cast a unanimous ballot to elect those nominated. Motion seconded by Karl Lundquist and carried. Thanks was expressed to those who serve on these positions.

The Auditing Committee report was given by Jim Pelan who reported that the committee met, audited the books and found them to be in good order. A motion was made by Jon Seagren to accept this report. Motion seconded by Rachel Wise and carried.

Reports:

- 1. Pastor Eldal presented his report thanking those who help with the various activities in our congregation. He reviewed the pastoral acts and statistics that are printed in the annual report and expressed concern regarding the drop in average attendance. He also noted that we will be looking at the statistics for total membership to try and account for those who are baptized here, but live elsewhere. The memorials given in 2016 were noted. There were no questions or comments from those present.
- 2. The Outreach Committee report was given by James Unwin. He reported that there is \$27,711.15 to distribute to the entities listed in the annual report. He did note that some of the percentages to be given have changed from the previous year. There were no questions or comments.
- 3. The Financial Secretary and Treasurer's report was given by Audrey Unwin. She reported that there was a small loss in the general fund of \$1,145.10 as she reviewed the income and expenses for 2016. The fund report was reviewed and discussed.

A discussion arose regarding the church van noting that there are members who could benefit from this service. Jim Nelson questioned the status of the furnace and air conditioner installation and Greg replied he would discuss this later in the meeting. Ed Hanna noted that by keeping the sliding doors on the north side of the sanctuary closed it improved the acoustics making it easier to hear. Greg reported on the plan to purchase some hearing devices and we have applied for grant money to assist in this purchase. It was noted that the sliding doors are often left open allowing easier access between the rooms, however, this will be evaluated.

<u>Old Business:</u> Greg reported that the furnace and air conditioners have not yet been installed and this has been addressed with the contractor. The council has expressed its concerns and was informed that the bid that was submitted last year will still be honored. Plans are for installation to be done as soon as there is a spell of warmer weather. The project will be paid for using funds available and replenished from Outreach funds over a period of time.

<u>New Business:</u> The 2017 mission support projects, with funds distributed equally, are as follows: LCMC, Oakland Ministerial Association, Oakland Food Bank, Dr. Stuart Embury and Lutheran Family Services. The proposed budget was presented by Jon Seagren, who answered questions that arose. A motion was then made by Melinda Johnson to approve the 2017 budget and the benevolence plan. Motion seconded by Cheryl Denker and carried.

Greg reported that next year plans are for the highway to be repaved and because of this, the slope of our sidewalk will be changed. He also reported that we have applied for a grant to pay for replacing the sign on the west side of the church which is in disrepair. He reported it has been noted that there is cracking of the stucco on the south side of the building. The council has discussed setting aside some funds for the future painting of the exterior of the building. Greg noted that a clean-up day is needed as we are running out of space for storage. Leaders from each group will be asked to help and we want input from all organizations that have items stored in the building. Decisions will have to be made on what to do with the excess items. Greg thanked the newly elected members who will be serving on the council and Outreach Committee as well as thanking Cheryl Denker, Rachel Wise and Carl Magnusson who are going off the council. Melinda Johnson thanked the entire council for their work. It was noted that there will be a short organizational meeting of the council following the soup luncheon.

A question was raised as to what the official name of our church is and it is First Evangelical Lutheran Church. There was also a request to print LCMC on our weekly bulletins as a way to keep us aware of it.

An offering was taken that will be given to Dr. Stuart Embury's ministry.

There being no further business, a motion to adjourn was made by Jim Nelson, seconded by Candace Johnson and carried.

The meeting ended with Pastor leading us in prayer following by all saying the Lord's Prayer.
