For in Jesus we receive the gift of God's presence. Jesus would be "Immanuel," which means "God with us." In the gift of Jesus God comes to be with us.



# COUNCIL Oakland, Nebraska

The church council met November 7, 2016 at 7:00 pm. In attendance were Greg Johnson, Cheryl Denker, Sandy Husar, Carole Johnson, Karl Lundquist, Tom Meyer and Rachel Wise. The meeting opened with devotions given by Greg Johnson. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved. Pastor presented his report for September and October.

<u>The treasurer's report</u> was reviewed. Audrey Unwin, Treasurer, presented the profit and loss statement and facilitated the discussion on the year to year comparison of the budget and expenditures.

Old Business: Discussion was held on the donation of Bibles and hymnals to the church. Cheryl Denker moved to accept the donation of the Bibles. Motion was seconded and carried. Rachel Wise moved to request 10 copies of the hymnal and access to the online or digital rights from the donor. Motion was seconded and carried. The exterior door is not yet installed. It will be discussed next month. Discussion was held on the church sign over the entrance. The sign is in soft sandstone and will require additional information for repairing and repainting. Discussion was on seeking a stone mason or someone with similar expertise to provide a recommendation of what options there are for repairing the sign. Greg Johnson reported the electrical work is done in the upstairs classroom and it is ready for use. Finishing work will be explored at a later date. The heating and cooling system updates were discussed. Greg Johnson will follow up with the contractor and report back next month. Pastor has contacted Betty Starr regarding her desire to provide funding for a needed project at church. General needs were discussed.

Additional discussion was held on planning a church cleanup date to discard or donate items no longer needed by the church and to improve organization and evaluate storage needs. Greg will compile a list of group leaders, set a date and plan to get this accomplished before Christmas.

<u>New Business:</u> The Evangelism Committee report was provided. Nancy Johnson will be reporting out to the congregation on the information gathered at the Oct. 16<sup>th</sup> Harvest Moon event, the youth stepping stones or faith milestones and on using Right Now Media. Cheryl Denker has volunteered to lead the FLC Facebook team.

The next meeting will be December 5th at 7:00 pm at Pastor Mark and Jacque's home.


