The church council met September 6, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. In attendance were Greg Johnson, Sandy Husar, Rachel Wise, Sam Schmidt, Carl Magnusson, Cheryl Denker, Mona Tanksley, Kylie Penke, Jon Seagren, Karl Lundquist and Pastor Eldal. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and corrected to note that the meeting opened at 7:00 p.m. instead of 7:30

Pastor presented his report for August activities. There was no treasurer's report available.

**Old Business:** Kylie Penke was present to discuss the removal of the wall between two Sunday School rooms upstairs. As discussed previously, a bigger room would allow space for the high school and junior high to meet together. Plans are to have the room set up so media could be used for their studies. In discussing the removal of the wall, it was decided to start work on it Wednesday, September 14. Volunteers will meet at 6:00 p.m. to begin work and after the youth have had their meal they will assist in removing debris. While the room is under renovation we will look into the electrical needs i.e. outlets and light fixtures. There is need for some more bag chairs and Kylie noted that there is money in the youth account to pay for the purchase of these. In other business Greg reported that Tom Meyer has agreed to fill out the term of Kylie Penke who has resigned from the council. There was discussion about purchasing a fireproof safe in which church records would be stored. Sam has done some initial research and it was felt we needed to know where this would be housed so we would know what size to purchase. It was decided to table this until the next budget year. There was discussion again about the covering for the window wells. Jon will do some research about other possibilities.

The window screen is being repaired, but there was no report about the southwest door replacement.

**New Business: Property Committee:** It was reported that the parking spaces on the street have been repainted by Dan Tanksley.

The Evangelism Committee met tonight and Rachel gave an update on their activities. The Praise service will be held the second Sunday of each month. It is planned for children to provide special music and there will be a children's sermon as part of that service. The Sunday School kick off will be September 11th with plans for bowling at West Point. A visit to Harvest Moon is planned for October 16th by the Sunday School. Signup sheets will be posted for volunteers to sign up to help with providing food for the Wednesday night youth meetings. Plans are to have the pizza luncheon for teens again this school year the last Thursday of the month.

The Worship Committee. There was discussion about placing Bibles in the pews that a donor has offered to purchase. The idea of having children's Bibles available was also mentioned. Consideration is being given to purchasing racks to place under each pew for storage of Bibles/hymnals. Options were discussed and we will look to see what is available. It had been reported that the Normil Foundation was interested in making a donation towards the purchase of something for the church. Pastor will contact Betty Starr and give her a list of items she might be interested in purchasing, those being the hearing devices, an AED and the safe. The LCMC conference is October 2-5 in Denver. Pastor Eldal and Nancy Johnson will attend as representatives from our congregation.

The meeting adjourned with Pastor leading the group in the Lord's Prayer. The next meeting will be October 3 at 7:00 p.m.
