The church council met February 1, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. with the following members present: Greg Johnson, Cheryl Denker, Jon Seagren, Karl Lundquist, Carole Johnson, Mona Tanksley, Rachel Wise, Jim Pelan and Sam Schmidt. Pastor Eldal was also present.

Jon Seagren opened the meeting by reading devotions. Greg called the meeting to order and welcomed the new council members. The minutes of the January 4 meeting were read and accepted. The minutes of the January 24 meeting were then read and also accepted.

The list of various committees was distributed and council members signed up for the committee they wished to serve on.

Pastor Eldal presented his report of January activities. The Treasurer's report of profit and loss statement was reviewed and discussed.

Old Business: It was reported that the new phone system is to be installed later this week.

<u>New Business:</u> Upcoming worship service schedule was discussed. There will be two services on Ash Wednesday at 10 a.m. and 7 p.m. both with communion. There will be five Lenten services at 6:30 followed by a meal. A video series will probably be used for the Lenten services. Maundy Thursday and Good Friday services will be held at 7 p.m. There will be two Easter Sunday services held at the same time as last years' services.

There was discussion regarding buses parking in the parking lot and weight limits. It was reported that in order to limit buses/trucks from parking in the lot we must have a sign that specifies the weight limit allowed. We will check into signage for weight limits. It was reported that we will have the organ checked again as it has not been working properly. The state of the furnaces was discussed noting that Vern Zessin has been here to check them. It is estimated that the furnaces are approximately 30 years old. The outside timers for the lights will be checked to make sure they are working properly. There was a discussion regarding fire extinguishers and we will check with our insurance agent to see if there is a requirement on how often they must be checked to insure they are working. Snow removal was discussed with the questions raised on what to do if we need to remove snow from our property. A new sound bar will be installed for the new television in the multipurpose room.

We still have the tables that were removed from the multipurpose room and it was agreed to sell them for \$25.00 each to anyone interested in them.

<u>The Evangelism</u> committee will plan to meet in March. There was discussion about having a second contemporary service and using the screen more often.

Sam thanked the council for the flower arrangement given in memory of his grandfather.


