# First Evangelical Lutheran Church Oakland, Nebraska

The Church Council met October 5, 2015 with Cheryl Denker calling the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. In attendance were Jim Pelan, Greg Johnson, Carl Magnusson, Rachel Wise, Sandy Husar, Sam Schmidt, Mona Tanksley, Jan Wiltse, Jon Seagren, Kylie Penke and Roger Moderow. Pastor Eldal was attending the LCMC convention so was not in attendance.

The devotions were given by Mona Tanksley after which the minutes of the previous meeting were read. A motion was made by Jon, seconded by Rachel to approve them. Motion carried.

**The Evangelism Committee** reported that they will meet in November. The sign up calendars for assisting with activities will be posted for the remainder of the year in the multipurpose room. Members are encouraged to sign up to assist with the various activities. It was reported there were 17 young people attending the gathering last Wednesday evening.

The financial reports for September and year to date were reviewed noting expenses exceeded income by \$3,500 so far this year.

The Property Committee noted the new white tables were up in the multiple purpose room and ideas of what to do with the tables that were discussed. It was felt that some of the windows need to be caulked and we will get a quote for this from Linde Glass. We will also check on the piece of glass that was ordered to go on the top of the organ to protect the wood. Jim Pelan reported that the television should be arriving soon and will be installed as soon possible. It was also reported that the Dorcas organization has agreed to contribute to the purchase of the television. Other items discussed included seeding of grass north of the parking lot, a light fixture downstairs that needs tightening, carpets in need of cleaning for which Jim will check on getting a bid for this service. Jim offered to post the directions for using the elevator in the elevator. We will find a place to store the Vacation Bible School supplies to have them available at another time.

**Old Business:** Church organizations were reminded to store left over food to help control the problem with mice. Plans for updating the church's phone service are still in the works and this should occur in the near future.

**New Business:** Interviews were conducted for the clerical position and Vanessa Nelson ultimately was hired. She will begin this month and will start by being in the office two mornings a week for now. Sunday October 11 is Pastor Appreciation Sunday and it was decided to purchase a gift card for Pastor and present it to him on that day. It was reported that there is still some money in the organ fund and the parking lot fund and it was decided to return this money to the memorial fund.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned with all praying the Lord's Prayer.


