The church council met June 1, 2015 at 7:30 p.m. with the following persons present: Cheryl Denker, Jan Wiltse, Rachel Wise, Kylie Penke, Carl Magnusson, Greg Johnson, Jon Seagren, Sam Schmidt, Roger Moderow, Jim Pelan, Mona Tanksley and Pastor Eldal.

Pastor presented his report for May highlighting his activities for the month.

It was noted that the financial report was not available at this time.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and a motion was made by Jon to accept them. Motion seconded by Sam and carried.

<u>The Evangelism Committee report</u> was given by Rachel who reported on their recent meeting. They are looking at ways to welcome new members and visitors. An information packet will be sent to these people. Information on our church will also be included in the city welcome packets distributed to new residents. A "sign in" sheet was shown that will be placed in the pews for all to sign in addition to being used as a replacement for the communion cards. The first youth outreach event was held in May with 15 young people attending. These events will be held the first and third Wednesdays through the summer. Kylie Penke reported on the Right Now media that is available to all members of our congregation via the internet. In addition to videos, there are Bible studies available for all age groups. The email distribution list has been compiled and the Spire will soon be sent via email in addition to being sent in the mail. Cheryl, Rachel and Pastor met recently to write a job description for the part time position that we have discussed hiring. A motion was made by Rachel that we move forward to hire a part time media specialist based on the information given. Motion seconded by Greg and carried. A personnel committee has been formed to handle the details of hiring the person for this position. The committee consists of Pastor, Cheryl, Kylie, Rachel, Jon, and Greg. This position will be announced in church and a notice placed in the Spire.

<u>The Music Committee</u> noted that choir has ended for the season. The choir and musicians will meet at Pop and Doc's for a meal on June 12. It was reported that the pianos have been tuned recently.

<u>The Property Committee report</u> was given by Jim who noted that Sean Linder will soon be working on the sprinkler system. It was also noted that there are some areas in the lawn in need of re-seeding. The mowing service was discussed. Dan Tanksley has been contacted about painting the parking stalls on the south side of the building. It was decided to have him paint the ones on the west side of the church at the same time. The television for the multipurpose room was discussed and Jim will check regarding cost of the wiring.

Old Business: We continue to work on the membership list to update all the information.

<u>New Business:</u> Pastor reported that a community church service will be held on Sunday, June 21 at the park as part of the Swedish Festival. He noted that the Burt County Brass will perform at our service on June 28. It was decided that there would not be a worship service on Saturday evening, July 4. We discussed the idea of doing a fund raiser by selling fruit and details were given by Mona. This information will be given to the WOW groups to decide whether to proceed with it.
