We are excited to bring you a faster check-in on Registration Day! This year when you arrive to check-in for camp, you will be given a check-in sheet that will contain your camper's information - including the amount you've prepaid and the current balance due. 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UPDATES & IMPROVEMENTS



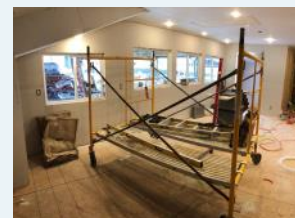
Last year, the back deck was repaired. This spring, we added the finishing touches—stairs with landing areas. The cement pad outside the back door was also redone and expanded to meet up with the stairs.



A lot of time and work has gone into Nebel Hall this winter/spring. With a subsidy from our electric company and through a generous donation, we were able to change all of the lighting in the building to LED. Time was also spent in the kitchen—putting in new washable walls, redoing some plumbing and electrical work, and replacing the lights.



Downstairs was also given a lighting upgrade and fresh coats of paint throughout. Finally, thanks to the ladies at Women's Weekend, we were able to purchase new stoves, which will be installed very soon, for the kitchen.



The Canteen was totally demolished this past fall, and we've spent the month of April rebuilding it. It will now have heat/air, water, a new fridge, a soda fountain, an ice machine, and MORE! We can't wait for you to see it!
