Proverbs 10:19—When words are many, sin is not absent, but he who holds his tongue is wise.

Proverbs 12:6—The words of the wicked lie in wait for blood, but the speech of the upright rescues them.



Proverbs 12:19—Truthful lips endure forever, but a lying tongue lasts only a moment.
