





This "last word" . . .

1. Reminds us of <u>fulfilled</u> <u>prophecy</u>



- His betrayal by Judas

- Predicted: Psalm 41:9 "Even my close friend in whom I trusted, who ate my bread, has lifted his heel against me."
- 2. Fulfilled: Mark 14:10-11 "Then Judas Iscariot, who was one of the twelve, went to the chief priests in order to betray him to them. And when they heard it, they were glad and promised to give him money. And he sought an opportunity to betray him."



- <u>His disciples would scatter</u>

- 1. Predicted: Zechariah 13:7 "Strike the shepherd, and the sheep will be scattered;"
- 2. Fulfilled: Mark 14:50 "And they all left him and fled."



- <u>The price of His betrayal</u>

- Predicted: Zechariah 11:12 "Then I said to them, "If it seems good to you, give me my wages; but if not, keep them." And they weighed out as my wages thirty pieces of silver."
- Fulfilled: Matthew 26:15 "and said, "What will you give me if I deliver him over to you?" And they paid him thirty pieces of silver."




- <u>His scourging</u>

- Predicted: Isaiah 50:6 "I gave my back to those who strike, and my cheeks to those who pull out the beard; I hid not my face from disgrace and spitting."
- Fulfilled: Matthew 27:26-30 "Then he released for them Barabbas, and having scourged Jesus, delivered him to be crucified."



- <u>The false witnesses</u>

- 1. Predicted: Psalm 35:11 "Malicious witnesses rise up; they ask me of things that I do not know."
- 2. Fulfilled: Mark 14:55-57 "Now the chief priests and the whole council were seeking testimony against Jesus to put him to death, but they found none. For many bore false witness against him, but their testimony did not agree. And some stood up and bore false witness against him,"



- <u>He did not defend Himself</u>

- 1. Predicted: Isaiah 53:7 "He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth; like a lamb that is led to the slaughter, and like a sheep that before its shearers is silent, so he opened not his mouth."
- 2. Fulfilled: Matthew 27:13-14 "Then Pilate said to him, "Do you not hear how many things they testify against you?" But he gave him no answer, not even to a single charge, so that the governor was greatly amazed."



- <u>His ID with criminals</u>

Predicted: Isaiah 53:12 – "Therefore I will divide him a portion with the many, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong, because he poured out his soul to death and was numbered with the transgressors; yet he bore the sin of many, and makes intercession for the transgressors." Fulfilled: Luke 23:32-33 – "Two others, who were 2. criminals, were led away to be put to death with him. And when they came to the place that is called The Skull, there they crucified him, and the criminals, one on his right and one on his left."



- <u>He was pierced</u>

- Predicted: Psalm 22:16 "For dogs encompass me; a company of evildoers encircles me; they have pierced my hands and feet"
- 2. Fulfilled: Mark 15:25 "And it was the third hour when they crucified him." John 20:25-27 – "So the other disciples told him, "We have seen the Lord." But he said to them, "Unless I see in his hands the mark of the nails, and place my finger into the mark of the nails, and place my hand into his side, I will never believe."



- <u>Parting His garments</u>

- 1. Predicted: Psalm 22:18 "they divide my garments among them, and for my clothing they cast lots."
- 2. Fulfilled: John 19:24 "so they said to one another, "Let us not tear it, but cast lots for it to see whose it shall be." This was to fulfill the Scripture which says, "They divided my garments among them, and for my clothing they cast lots." So the soldiers did these things,"




- <u>Given vinegar to drink</u>

- 1. Predicted: Psalm 69:21 "for my thirst they gave me sour wine to drink."
- Fulfilled: Matthew 27:34 "they offered him wine to drink, mixed with gall, but when he tasted it, he would not drink it."



- <u>He interceded for others</u>

- 1. Predicted: Isaiah 53:12 "Therefore I will divide him a portion with the many, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong, because he poured out his soul to death and was numbered with the transgressors; yet he bore the sin of many, and makes intercession for the transgressors."
- 2. Fulfilled: Luke 23:34 "And Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do."



- The height of His suffering

- Predicted: Psalm 22:1 "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me? Why are you so far from saving me, from the words of my groaning?"
- Fulfilled: Matthew 27:46 "And about the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, "Eli, Eli, lema sabachthani?" that is, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?"



- <u>Pierced with a spear</u>

- Predicted: Zechariah 12:10 "And I will pour out on the house of David and the inhabitants of Jerusalem a spirit of grace and pleas for mercy, so that, when they look on me, on him whom they have pierced, they shall mourn for him, as one mourns for an only child, and weep bitterly over him, as one weeps over a firstborn."
- 2. Fulfilled: John 19:34, 37 "But one of the soldiers pierced his side with a spear,"



- <u>No bones were broken</u>

- Predicted: Psalm 34:20 "He keeps all his bones; not one of them is broken."
- 2. Fulfilled: John 19:32-33, 36 "So the soldiers came and broke the legs of the first, and of the other who had been crucified with him. But when they came to Jesus and saw that he was already dead, they did not break his legs. For these things took place that the Scripture might be fulfilled: "Not one of his bones will be broken."



- Buried by a rich man

- Predicted: Isaiah 53:8-9 "And they made his grave with the wicked and with a rich man in his death, although he had done no violence, and there was no deceit in his mouth."
- 2. Fulfilled: Matthew 27:57-60 "When it was evening, there came a rich man from Arimathea, named Joseph, who also was a disciple of Jesus. He went to Pilate and asked for the body of Jesus. Then Pilate ordered it to be given to him. And Joseph took the body and wrapped it in a clean linen shroud and laid it in his own new tomb,"






