Spiritual Gifts

2 Corinthians 12:1 – “Now concerning spiritual gifts, brothers, I do not want you to be unaware.”

1 Timothy 4:14 – “Do not neglect the spiritual gift within you.”

Spiritual Gifts

A God-given ability that enables the Christian to function in God's family with ease, efficiency, and sense of accomplishment.

KNOWING YOUR SPIRITUAL GIFT:

1) Helps you discover your purpose in life

- Ephesians 2:10 – “For we are God’s workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.”

- Ephesians 4:1 – “Live a life worthy of the calling you have received”

KNOWING YOUR SPIRITUAL GIFT:

2) Helps you find freedom from insecurity and inferiority

- 1 Peter 4:10 – “As each one has received a special gift, employ it in serving one another.”
- 1 Corinthians 12:4-5 – “There are different spiritual gifts, but the same spirit gives them. There are different ways of serving, and yet the same Lord is served.”















KNOWING YOUR SPIRITUAL GIFT:

3) Helps keep you motivated and encouraged

- Galatians 6:9 – “Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up.”

2. What does the Bible teach about spiritual gifts?

- I am to discover/deploy the gifts God gives me
- An unused gift will result in a wasted life
- Using my gifts honors God and grows me
