• DISCIPLINE IS <u>GUIDANCE</u> & <u>CORRECTION</u> DRIVEN BY LOVE.

"Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord." Ephesians 6:4 (NASB)

◆ Ektrephō (ek-tre'-fō): <u>"bring up, nourish or nurture to</u> maturity"

◆ Paideia (pī-dā'-ä): instruction aimed at increasing virtue; whole training/systematic plan for education of children; intentional cultivation of mind and morals; where we get our word — pedagogy

◆ Nouthesia (*nü-the-sē'-ä*): exhortation, admonition; verbal guidance; training with our words — literally "laying out the understanding" OR "putting into your mind"

5 "My son, do not make light of the Lord's discipline, and do not lose heart when he rebukes you, 6 because the Lord disciplines those he loves, and he punishes everyone he accepts as a son." Hebrews 12:5-6

- Elegchō (*e-le'n-khō*): to correct, refute, reprehend severely, to call to account, to punish
- ◆ Mastigoō (mä-stē-go'-ō): scourge; punish

"Discipline your son, for in that there is hope; do not be a willing party to his death." Proverbs 19:18

Rules without <u>Relationship</u> will lead to <u>Rebellion</u>. - Josh McDowell Undisciplined Parents

1. <u>LIFEGUARD</u> Parents: often <u>RESCUE</u> a child from Consequences.

Do not be deceived: God cannot be mocked. A man reaps what he sows. Galatians 6:7

2. ETCH-A-SKETCH Parents: often INCONSISTENT.

¹⁵ The rod of correction imparts wisdom, but a child left undisciplined disgraces his mother. ¹⁷ Discipline your children, and they will give you peace; they will bring delight to your soul. Proverbs 29:15, 17

3. SPLIT-DECISION Parents: Often NON-UNIFIED.

Do two walk together unless they have agreed to do so?

Amos 3:3

PARENTAL EXPECTATIONS

1. We Expect <u>FIRST</u>-Time AND <u>CHEERFUL</u> Obedience.

"Children, obey your parents in everything, for this pleases the Lord." Colossians 3:20

"Do everything without complaining or arguing...." Philippians 2:14

DISCIPLINE MORE FOR ATTITUDE THAN ACTIONS.

2. We Agree to Never Discipline in <u>ANGER</u>.

In your anger do not sin. Ephesians 4:26 (For verses on spanking, see Proverbs 3:12, 13:24, 22:15)

3. We Will Discipline Promptly With <u>INSTRUCTION</u> and <u>RECONCILIATION</u>.

Fathers, do not exasperate your children; instead, bring them up in the training and instruction of the Lord." Ephesians 6:4 (NIV)
