

Prerequisites

The School of Kingdom Ministry is meant to be a comprehensive training course in the gifts of the Spirit for people who have already been activated at a basic level in Holy Spirit ministry. For this reason all School of Kingdom Ministry students get to participate in a **Prayer Training Course** that equips students in the Five-Step Prayer Model. This prerequisite class will be taught on **Saturday, September 16, 2017 at 9:30 am.**

Tuition

The goal of the School of Kingdom Ministry is to offer top-notch supernatural ministry training to the everyday person. To that end, we keep our costs at a minimum so as many people can participate as possible. That means we charge hundreds, not thousands of dollars. The Price reflected is for the entire 9-month school year.

Graduation Requirements

The School of Kingdom Ministry holds a high value for the quality of training it offers. Students are held to a high standard because excellence is always present with the Kingdom of God.

In order for students to successfully complete Year One of the School of Kingdom Ministry, they must:

- Be present and participate in at least 24 of the 27 class sessions and practice activities.
- Participate in ministry prayer teams during the end of the Sunday service (if you attend New Beginning) and during your Fellowship Group (If you're not in one now's a good time to join one.).
- Participate in at least one organized outreach during the course of the school semester.
- Participate in at least one activity focused on training others to do kingdom ministry during the course of the school term (this requirement is excused if the student is already leading in a Fellowship Group or some other ministry).
- Complete the homework assignment given for the break between first and second semester.
- Regularly attend and participate in your church home throughout the school term.

Why School of Kingdom Ministry?

What is School of Kingdom Ministry?

The School of Kingdom Ministry functions as a resourcing and training agent to a network of churches hosting sites around the world. The express purpose of SOKM is to continue Jesus' supernatural ministry in the power of the Holy Spirit through Christians.

What you'll experience at School of Kingdom Ministry

- **Weekly Video Teaching**

Students take part in 27 weeks of classroom sessions at their local SOKM site. These teachings include topics like: identity, relationships, supernatural ministry, and shaping your Christian worldview.

- **Facilitators**

Each SOKM location has a trained facilitator. This facilitator is a support and guide throughout your time in the school. The local facilitator also creates hands on practice activities and learning opportunities at their site.

- **Resources**

School of Kingdom Ministry provides resources for students to use inside and outside of the classroom. Students have online access to class teachings, articles, and other video resources through our student portal.



- **Class Format**

The School of Kingdom Ministry is designed to run as a three hour class once a week for nine months. New Beginning's SOKM will meet on Monday from 6:30-9:30 pm. *Within the three hours of class, students will experience:*

Teaching

A high quality video teaching curriculum focuses on discipleship and power ministry that guides students into a deeper understanding of their faith. In addition, students get a copy of the SOKM manual & notes.

Activation

Local leaders take their students through a series of activities that give the Holy Spirit room to move and activate the students in gifts of the Spirit in a hands-on way.

Practice

Students put what they are learning into practice in the ministry contexts that exist in your local church. This variety of experiences will stretch and grow every student.

At Each Class our plan is to serve a "light" dinner before class (5:45 pm) and to offer childcare on a donation basis.

- **Student Resources**

The journey of growing in Holy Spirit ministry is as much a journey we walk by ourselves as we do with others. We all grow in the context of community; yet at the same time, it is **your** relationship with God – no one else's! To that end we also provide a number of resources to students to help them on their own journey of growth in addition to the training and teaching provided in the School of Kingdom Ministry.
