## Words of Encouragement...

John 12:32 ➤ *“And I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all people to myself.”* NLT

After a year and a half of planning, and a year of publicity, our church-wide retreat has come and gone. It's actually hard to believe after all the praying and planning, that it's done.

I must confess that, even though I thought I'd heard from the Lord about doing this, sought counsel from the church staff and the Deacons, and all of them encouraged me to press forward with it – I wavered in my confidence that I had heard clearly and correctly about encouraging us as a church to go together on this retreat.

But, oh how the Lord is faithful – even when our faith wobbles. God proved Himself once again by pouring-out His love and blessing. The Holy Spirit truly moved among us and blessed us.

During one of the messages, Mike shared of a recent personal experience he had. (You will very likely hear me share this story again sometime 😊.)

Mike told us he had recently gone to a barber shop – which we all laughed about, since he is bald. While he was sitting in a chair waiting, a man sitting across from him asked if he was a preacher. Mike didn't know the man, and he wondered what that question suggested about his appearance. But, he answered the man, “Yes, I'm a preacher.”

The man introduced himself as Fritz, and asked Mike if he would pray for him. Fritz shared with Mike that his mother was in a nearby hospital suffering with late stages of Alzheimer's disease. Fritz continued to share that in the hospital he had recently asked his mother, “What makes you extraordinary, Mom?” Fritz reminded Mike that his mother's Alzheimer's had progressed to the point that she no longer remembered his name, his sister's name, or her own name.

Fritz said his mother answered his question about what made her extraordinary without any hesitation. She declared: “My Jesus, the Son of the living God!”

She called to memory the only name that mattered – Jesus. When all memory was gone, she spoke the only name that rose in her mind. She spoke the name above all other names. Jesus.

The truth is, that name – the name of Jesus – is the only name that matters in our lives as well. When all in our life is said and done, the only name that will matter – the only name that will have made any difference – is Jesus.

Dear loved ones, let all of us with all our voice, with all our life, with all that we have, lift up the one name that is above all other names – the name of Jesus. When we're asked what makes us extraordinary – what makes us different – may we, like Fritz's mother, declare; “Jesus, the Son of the living God!”

## Associate Pastor/Youth Minister NEWS

**"So I sent for you at once, and it was good of you to come. Now we are all here, waiting before God to hear the message the Lord has given you"** (Acts 10:33, NLT).

Talk about a pastoral visit! The context of this verse is that of Peter hearing the explanation of Cornelius as to why Peter was summoned to his home. God wanted the Gentile people to hear the Gospel.

However, today, that same verse could be an indication of what some households expect from their pastoral staff. "We have all gathered, preacher...tell us what the Bible says." For Family Ministry, this concept is all too often the reality. It is a concept that Dr. Tim Kimmel calls, "sub-contracted parenthood" (*Connecting Church & Home*, 2013).

Do not hear me wrong--I believe that Children's Ministers and Youth Ministers are vital to the life and growth of the local church. However, I also believe that the role is more of a "partnership/coaching" role rather than that of a "spiritual EMT."

The family unit is the primary spiritual unit responsible for spiritual formation. It is what Kimmel says is, "The Domestic Church, while the local church is a gathering of Domestic Churches". This is God's plan for the family, but because of a fallen world, the family may not be doing this. This is where the church steps in. Praise God for people willing teach Sunday school and Life Groups, and for people willing to be the example to those who need it!

In keeping with this ideology, we (FBC Bangs) will host a few events to facilitate this concept.

- First, we will be having a **Sunday School/Life Group Teacher Workshop** on **March 25<sup>th</sup>** immediately following the morning service. Lunch will be provided.
- Then, in April, we will focus on the family. We will host a **Parenthood Seminar/Workshop** that is open for anyone to attend. It will be **April 14<sup>th</sup> from 9AM-Noon**. Continental style breakfast provided. Be looking for the flyers around the church.
- On **April 15<sup>th</sup>**, we will have a **Parent/Child Dedication Service** in the Morning Worship. Contact the church office or me if you would like to participate.

Together we can begin to weld the connection between church and home so that the bond will be virtually indestructible. **"Strong churches don't make strong families; strong families make strong churches"**
