

Do you know that it is a privilege to praise the Lord.

- One of the ways we praise the Lord is by saying or singing the word hallelujah.



Hallelujah is written as one word.

- Hallel means to praise.
- The question remains, praise what?
- Praise Jah, shorten form of Hebrew name for Lord YHWH.
- Which is pronounced Yahweh.
- Hallelujah means to praise the Lord.

**Psalm 89:5 (NASB)**

<sup>5</sup> The heavens will praise Your wonders, O LORD; Your faithfulness also in the assembly of the holy ones.

**Psalm 138:4 (NASB)**

<sup>4</sup> All the kings of the earth will give thanks to You, O LORD, When they have heard the words of Your mouth.

We can praise the Lord with *singing*.

**Isaiah 12:5 (NASB)**

<sup>5</sup> Praise the LORD in song, for He has done excellent things; Let this be known throughout the earth.

We can praise the Lord with *shouting*.


**Psalm 98:4 (NASB)**

### **Psalm 150:4 (NASB)**

<sup>4</sup> Praise Him with timbrel and dancing;

pipe.

flood our minds we can use a God given tool.*


*Raise A Hallelujah*
