

Here are a few of the topics/questions I'll address in this series:

- Death: it's not what you think; it's much worse!
- Resurrection: it's not what you've been taught; it's so much better!
- I thought I was "going to heaven"? Are we back on planet earth?
- Why does the Ascension of Jesus into heaven matter for me right now?
- If God loves everyone, why isn't everyone "going to heaven"?
- Is there really a hell? Or are unbelievers just "annihilated"?
- Why should I be thinking about any of this right now?

I look forward to seeing you in January, and finding out what other questions you have about what's coming "Next"!

- February 1st Share the Love card making event with Lisa Ambrose. A light lunch will be served. Open house from 10:00-2:00 in the Fellowship hall.






Adults!


Youth News!
