I. P.P.P. à Petition #1 à Petition #2

- A. Global perspective (God’s sovereign will) leads to
Local perspective (God’s personal will)
- B. Jesus understood HIS PERSONAL desire to do God’s will (John 6:38; Matt. 7:21)
- C. Our purpose is to know and do God’s will (Eph. 1:7-10)

II. Petition #2 – Our world must submit and do your will now

- A. Urgency for the world to be in alignment with the absolute will of God
(Aorist Imperative **Passive**)
Thelema = Desire/planning that leads to expectations of action
- B. Three parts of Thelema:
 - 1. God’s desire – knowing the expectations that God has for you
 - a. God’s command will – God’s truths revealed for all believers
 - b. God’s personal will – God’s expectations for us personally
 - 2. Alignment – our actions in alignment with the desires of God
 - a. Gethsemane prayer (Matt. 26:39)
 - b. “Yoked with Christ” (Matt. 11:28 – 30)
 - 3. Work – Completing the works to accomplish the desires of God
Being about “The Father’s business” (Lk. 2:49; I Cor. 15:58; Jn 4:34; Phil 2:13)
- C. We are each given free will by God in order to be righteous before God
 - 1. Angels rebelled against God’s will (Isa. 13:12; Lk 10:18; Rev. 12:3-9)
 - 2. Humanity is provided with a choice to obey (Gen. 2:16,17)
 - 3. We have to make a moment by moment choice do God’s will
(Joshua 24:15; I Kings 18:21; John 14:15; Matt. 26:39)

- A. Pray to know and understand God’s will for your day
- B. Step out of your comfort zone
- C. Seek the counsel of Godly people to help you apply God’s will
