“Then the Lord said to Satan, ‘Have you considered my servant Job? There is no one on earth like him; he is blameless and upright, a man who fears God and shuns evil.’”

I. Main Character #1 – God (Job 1:6)

- A. ‘Elohiym = Plural (Trinity) – Creator/Sustainer
- B. Yahweh = “The Existing One” – “I am that I am”
- C. The angels (including Satan) come to report to God (vs. 6)
- D. Outside the created order/Over all/Sovereign

II. Main Character #2 – Satan (Job 1:7 – 12)

- A. Lucifer/Satan/Devil - One of the “angels”
- B. Created beings – limited by space and time
- C. Questioned by God (vs. 7 – 11)
- D. Limited by God in his scope of evil (vs. 12)

III. Main Character #3 – Job (Job 1:1 – 5)

- A. Name = “Job” = “Hated/Persecuted”
- B. Righteous Man: (vs. 1)
 - 1) Blameless = Morally right with God
 - 2) Upright = Honest in the eyes of men
 - 3) Fearing God = Proper respect for God
 - 4) Shunning Evil = Refuse to associate with evil
- C. Blessed Businessman and Family man (2 – 3)
- D. High priest for his family (4 – 5)

IV. Main Point: The Source of Faith

- A. Definition of Faith (Heb. 11:1) – GK. Pistis = confidence/trust/movement
- B. Job was a righteous man – but his faith was NOT in his goodness
- C. Job was a wealthy and worldly successful man – but his faith was NOT in his wealth or family
- D. Job had faith in God even when he could not see what or why things were happening to him
