5 Simple Ways You Can Make This Lesson Stick With Your Kids

THIS WEEK'S LESSON: THE PROPHETS



IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

Today we talked about the prophets, whose job it was to call out Israel for its sins and tell of the coming Messiah. It wasn't easy being a prophet, but the prophets knew if they did not speak out for God, no one else would! They set an example we need to follow so the world can know that Jesus died for them.



HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Watch the news with your kids this week. Ask them: if prophets were alive today, what might they say about our world?



AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- Who were the prophets?
- Why did the kings hate the prophets?
- Why is it important that we share the good news of Jesus?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"Your word is a lamp for my feet, a light on my path." - Psalm 119:105 (NIV)



PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:

God wants us to stand strong for Him like the prophets did. That doesn't mean we have to tell the future, just tell what we know. Ask God for the courage to do the right thing and make choices that will be pleasing to Him, and ask Him for the right words to say when you are challenged about your faith.
