THIS WEEK'S LESSON: THE TRUST EXPERIMENT



IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

When Jesus was arrested, Peter was scared and denied that he even knew Jesus.

Kids will learn that we should trust God even when we're scared. Mark 14:66-72, Peter Denies Jesus
