

5 Simple Ways You Can Make This Lesson Stick With Your Kids

THIS WEEK'S LESSON: EXPLODING BAG



IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

Today we learned how to make a paper bag explode. We also learned that when life gets crazy, we can trust Jesus to take control and help us. Mark 5:1-20, Jesus Heals A Demon-Possessed Man.



RHANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Take a walk on a windy day, and watch how the leaves and other debris get blown around by the wind. Ask the kids how Jesus can take control of things when life seems out of control. Share a story of your own, if you have one, about how Jesus took control during a crazy time in your life.



AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- What was wrong with the man Jesus met down by the tombs?
- How did Jesus take control of the man's problem?
- How can Jesus help us when life feels out of control?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"He performs wonders that cannot be fathomed, miracles that cannot be counted." - Job 5:9 (NIV)



MPARENT TIME:

What you need to know:

Is your family going through a crazy time? Are there changes happening? Have you lost someone special? Pray as a family for God's help, and ask him to take control for all of you.
