THIS WEEK'S LESSON: TROUBLE

IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home: Today we talked about what it means to be in Trouble and what it means to get a second chance. Just as God gave Moses a second chance, God is always giving us second chances when we fail him.

HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

AT DINNER:

III PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:

We have a loving God who will always give us second chances. Thank him for his goodness, and if you're needing a second chance, ask him for one today.
