Ministry Update from your Church and Community Ministries Director

Greetings from Steven and Sylvia.

In his book, "Autopsy of a Deceased Church", Thom Rainer includes a chapter on "The Great Commission Becomes The Great Omission." One of the New Testament passages where Jesus sends out his followers is Matthew 28:19-20. The first word in this passage is "**Go**". We are to go, to make disciples, to baptize, to teach. We are to **go**, and to depend totally upon the power of Christ. That is why Jesus reminds us that, "I am with you always."

I have the pleasure of speaking to many church groups, and it does my heart good, to see how members are "going". They are getting out of their comfort zones in order to reach others with the Gospel. They have ramped up their missions' focus.

That may include a trip to the Amazon, to the Congo, to Haiti, or the Bahama's. I have been pleasantly surprised by the different age groups of people going on these trips. But "foreign" missions in only a small part of what we see going on locally. Churches are going on "prayer walks" in their neighborhoods and in the downtown business districts. We are seeing the Evangelism Trailer going out in record numbers to churches reaching their community through block parties, community festivals, and church events. Some have opened their facilities to after school activities such as basketball, and including a snack and short Bible study. We see ideas such as "The Table" or "Love Thy Neighbor" where Sunday School classes or individual couples invite their neighbors over for a meal. That neighbor may hear about what having a relationship with Jesus is all about, or just witness the love and excitement of being a Christian. Some may even join your church.

I am also excited about the CEF **Good News Clubs**, FCA, and other ways churches are gaining access to the local schools, in order to introduce Jesus to children. Have you had that conversation with your local principle or teachers?



Our Association churches are serving a meal at Grace Marketplace the first Saturday of every month. Hurting people are loved on, prayed with, or just given an ear for listening. Bibles, New Testaments, hygiene products, and donations are plentiful. Just this week, we delivered a trailer load of donations to Grace Marketplace, including furniture. Groups are calling about **the Helping Hands Christmas Wish List**, and signing up for items. If you or your group are interested in helping, please call the office.

I am excited! We have churches supporting foster families with the Baptist Children's Homes, and Partnership for Strong Families. Church members recently babysat almost 30 children while the parents enjoyed networking and an evening out without children. A few of our foster families recently added new foster children to their broods, including one that took in four siblings. Would you be prepared if suddenly you had four additional mouths to feed?

And remember our ministry partner, **Family Promise**, who works with homeless families, most of who had been living in their car. Just this week they donated five brand new twin beds that we will provide to our foster families. We were able to 'trade' them for pots, plates, other kitchen supplies, and chests of drawers that they needed, which were donated by you.

There is a lot to be excited about in the NCFBA, as many are answering the command of Jesus, to **'Go'**. Call me at 352-317-5631 and I will be glad to share with you.


