The 7 Qualities of a Great Kingdom Kids Volunteer:

1) A heart for God

This is where all ministry begins, whether you are teaching Sunday School or leading the entire church. In fact, this is where Kingdom Kids ministry should flow from – our deep, sincere, committed heart for God.

2) A love for people

Scripture teaches that the two greatest commands are to love God and to love . . . people (Mark 12:30-31)! Our teaching ought to flow *from* our love for God but *because of* our love for people.

3) A passion for God's Word

A heart for God and a love for people set the stage for the content of our teaching. And that content needs to be solidly based on Biblical truth.

4) A habit of praying

It is the power of God that brings about transformation, so a deep dependence on God, exhibited through the habit of praying, is essential for a great Kingdom Kids volunteer.



5) A commitment to personal growth

Luke 2:52 says that “Jesus grew in wisdom and stature and in favor with God and all the people.” Basically, he grew mentally, physically, spiritually and socially. A great example for our Kingdom Kids.

6) A dedication to the children

Jesus loved children, and even compared them to the Kingdom of God (Mark 10:13-16). We can demonstrate our love by showing an interest in their lives in and out of the classroom.

7) A willingness to show up

Love is demonstrated by the giving of our time to others. When we show up as a volunteer in Kingdom Kids we are showing the love of Christ. Time is valuable and giving it others in the name of Jesus is a sacrifice.
