



MORE THAN YOU CAN IMAGINE STORY

Optional supplies: Paper, pen/pencil

Directions:

1. This is a storytelling game for everyone to use their imagination and make their own creative story.
2. The first rule is that the story must begin with the following sentence: “There once was an alien named Zurg and he had special powers. He could...”
 - a. You can write individually and then share it with someone in your home. You can get together and write a story with someone in your home. You can go around the room in a circle, each adding a sentence onto the story. Or, you can sit with someone and make up a story together, aloud.
 - b. You may choose to draw your own pictures to go along with the story you create.
3. The second rule is, you must make the story as crazy as you can!

TALKING POINTS

Get together and talk about how this game helps us think about this week’s Bible story.

- That was fun getting to be creative and think about some crazy, unimaginable situations!
- Which parts of your story do you think are possible and could happen? Which parts of your story do you think are impossible and could never happen?
- God has given us a great imagination to dream up amazing things. But God can dream up more and has the most perfect imagination. Just look at what he has made in creation! Nothing is impossible for God.
- We learned that with God’s power we can do more than we could ever imagine. What is something only God can do? Think about something that would be impossible for you.
- How would you describe God’s power?
- Why do we need the Holy Spirit?
- Take some time to write down some prayers to God. Thank him that he has given his power to anyone who believes in Jesus to help them do amazing things.
