



ACT IT OUT

Directions:

1. Gather as many family members as you can in a circle.
2. The first person makes an action, and the next person repeats that action and adds one of their own onto it. The next person repeats both actions before them and adds their own, and so on.
3. Continue around the circle and see how many actions you can do before someone forgets an action.
4. When someone forgets an action, the next person starts a new sequence.
5. Play as many rounds as you would like.

TALKING POINTS

Get together and talk about how this game helps us think about this week's Bible story.

- This game reminds me how we are called to follow the plan God has for our lives. In this game, we have to act out what other people have asked us to do. But as Christians, the Holy Spirit gives us the power to live out what God has called us to do.
- We should live out what he has called us to do. But we cannot do this if we rely on our own strength alone! The Bible tells us that because of the power of the Holy Spirit, we can live the life God wants us to live.
- What are some things that God has called us all to do? Called you specifically to do? (Parents, this may be a great opportunity for you to share God's calling on your life.)
- How does the Holy Spirit help you do these things?
- God has an incredible plan for each and every one of us! He knows what is best for us and loves us so much. This is why we should follow what he says and rely on the Holy Spirit's power to help us understand what God has called each one of us to do.
- Has there ever been a time when something went different than you thought it was going to go? If so, how did it make you feel?
- Was there ever at time when making the right choice was hard. If so, what happened?
