On a recent Sunday we looked at the story of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego from the book of Daniel and we saw their amazing faith as they refused to bow down before an idol, even under the threat of being thrown into a fiery furnace.

From their lives and experience we were reminded that even though we may wonder, at times, if we can be helped in a trying situation there is always hope with God.

We were also encouraged to have a humble confidence in our God and to be unashamed of our faith in Jesus.

As we have this confidence in our God, we were reminded that we can have an "if not" faith. This is a faith that believes God will help us, but "if not," if he somehow does not seem to help us, we will still follow him and trust him. Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego chose to stand with God even if he did not rescue them from the fiery furnace.

We were reminded that God can walk with us in our fiery furnaces, just as he did with Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego.

Lastly, our passage taught us God's working in our lives is always perfect and complete. When Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego emerged from the fiery furnace they did not even smell like smoke. God's ministry to them was perfect and complete.

As we trust in Jesus as our Savior, may we follow him with the same kind of faith Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego had, being willing to follow him, whatever may happen, and whatever the cost.


