The Gospel of John, in many ways, is organized around a series of miracles called "signs." These "signs" seem to build to a crescendo as they begin with Jesus turning the water into wine and then progress through other "signs" leading ultimately to the greatest miracle of all, the resurrection of Jesus Christ.

It is this ultimate miracle, the resurrection of Jesus from the dead that we celebrate on Easter, and it is this miracle that can enable our lives to build to a crescendo as we trust in Jesus.

For the same power that raised Jesus from the dead can raise us to new life every day in him. It can be the "abundant life" of which Jesus spoke. This abundant life is not necessarily free of troubles and struggles, but rather a life filled with meaning and peace whatever the circumstances might be in which we live, even the uncertain ones which we are currently experiencing.

As we live the abundant life, we can as Paul would write, be led in "triumphal procession" by Jesus. As we are led in this procession it can eventually bring us to the ultimate miracle, resurrection from the dead someday.

Thus, in many ways the resurrection of Jesus can enable our lives to build to a crescendo as Jesus gives us new life here and now, and then ultimately raises us to life everlasting in him.

May the resurrected Jesus lead us in triumphal procession in this life and through eternity, as we trust in him as our Savior and Lord.

SUNDAY SCHOOL NEWS

Happy Easter to my Sunday school children and parents! The Sunday school teachers miss all of your faces, but as you know it is safer to be at home.

The coronavirus presents many challenges, but every obstacle is an opportunity. We have the privilege as parents to take this opportunity to guide our children towards the word of God.

Below are a few ideas for you:

- 1. Encourage kids to be "on mission" by writing cards of encouragement to first responders, pastors, schoolteachers, or nursing home residents. Have them call or FaceTime their grandparents and read a Bible verse or Bible story to them.
- 2. Post challenges for families such as taking a walk and talking about the beauty of the world God created. Do a scavenger hunt where kids find things specific things around the house that helps them tell the Bible story.
- 3. Explain that a virus or pandemic is wide-spread, but it doesn't mean everyone will get sick. We can reassure our children that their health and safety are our most important priority, and that we will do everything to protect them.

But don't stop there. Be a disciple maker. Besides reassurances, this is the time to share our God stories of how our faith grew strong in a difficult time. Children grow in the soil of our faith. Exposure to real hope and faith from a real person's life nurtures real faith. Be open. Be real. Be there. Be full of faith. This is child discipleship.

- 4. Use your child's hand and assign each finger a word. I. Am. Always. With. You. "When you are afraid, (insert your child's name) remember this prayer and that God is always with you."
- 5. Google Bible verses for your children and the coronavirus for comfort. One that stood out to me was:

Deuteronomy 31:8

The Lord himself goes before you and will be with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged

I believe if there's anything that we can do right now for our children is to bring God into our home on a daily basis to teach them that God is first and with that JOY comes into our life!


