Recently, in a Gospel lesson on Sunday morning we read of Jesus telling the parable of a father asking his two sons to go and work in his vineyard. When the father did so, one son responded by saying he would go and work, while the other son said he would not go. Yet, as the parable progressed, the son who said he would go into the vineyard did not go, while the son who said he would not go into the vineyard changed his mind, and did serve in the vineyard. Jesus then indicated it was the son who initially said "no," but who then served in the vineyard that did his father's will. It was this son who lived out a "yes" to his Father.

In many ways this parable is about living out a "yes" to God in our lives.

It can be a reminder that as we trust in Jesus he calls us to serve him even if at times we don't "feel like it." Hopefully, most of the time serving God is a joy and fills us with enthusiasm and vision. Yet even if we have moments where the warmth of faith fades and the joy of serving dims, Jesus still calls us to follow and serve him. He still calls us to live a "yes" even as we wait for the joy and vision to return.

As we trust in Jesus may we find great joy in serving him. Yet even if the joy temporarily diminishes in our lives may we still follow Jesus.

It is with great pleasure to announce First Lutheran Sunday School is starting back up with precautionary measures.

We plan to have our kick-off Sunday School party at the Harvest Moon Pumpkin Patch on Sunday, Oct. 4th at 10:45am after our Communion Service. We will plan to eat at the Pumpkin Patch from the time slot of 11:00am -12:00pm sharp! First Lutheran will pay for everyone's lunch, drink and dessert.




