THIS WEEK'S LESSON: JESUS IS GREATER THAN CANDY



IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

The best thing about Easter is not the sweet candy in our baskets, but the sweet news that candy reminds us of. It reminds us that because Jesus rose from the dead anyone who believes and accepts him as their Lord and Savior can be saved and spend forever with God. Mark 16:9-20, The Resurrection



M HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Enjoy some Easter candy with the kids. When you do, ask the kids why Jesus is sweeter than the candy you are enjoying together.



AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- What happened on the very first Easter morning?
- What is sweeter: Jesus or candy? Why?
- How can we share the good news of Jesus with others?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"He said to them, "Go into all the world. Preach the good news to everyone." Mark 16:15 (NIRV)



PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:
