THIS WEEK'S LESSON: WHAT A WRECK



IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

Peter boldly stepped out of the boat to walk on water with Jesus. While he kept his eyes on Jesus, Peter was fine. But when Peter focused on the wind and waves, he almost wrecked himself. Matthew 14:22-33, Jesus and Peter Walk on Water



HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Play some video games with your kids. When you do, see if you can distract them from the game. Then ask them why it's so easy to focus on video games but so hard to stay focused on Jesus.



AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- How was Peter able to walk on water?
- What happened when Peter looked away from Jesus?
- What can we do to keep our eyes on Jesus?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"The Lord is close to those whose hearts have been broken. He saves those whose spirits have been crushed." Psalm 34:18 (NirV)



PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:

God knows we are not perfect and we will never be able to fully stay focused on Christ, but the more we keep our eyes on Jesus, the more we will be able to serve and do God's will. Pray with your kids, and ask God to help all of you keep your eyes on Jesus.
