THIS WEEK'S LESSON: BUILD OBEDIENCE



IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

When the Israelites faced Jericho, it seemed impenetrable. But they had God on their side. When they obeyed God's instructions, the walls of Jericho crumbled like a pile of building bricks. Kids will use plenty of gray bricks to build the walls of the mighty city of Jericho. Joshua 6:1-20, The Fall of Jericho



HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:
