Jesus came to forgive our sins.

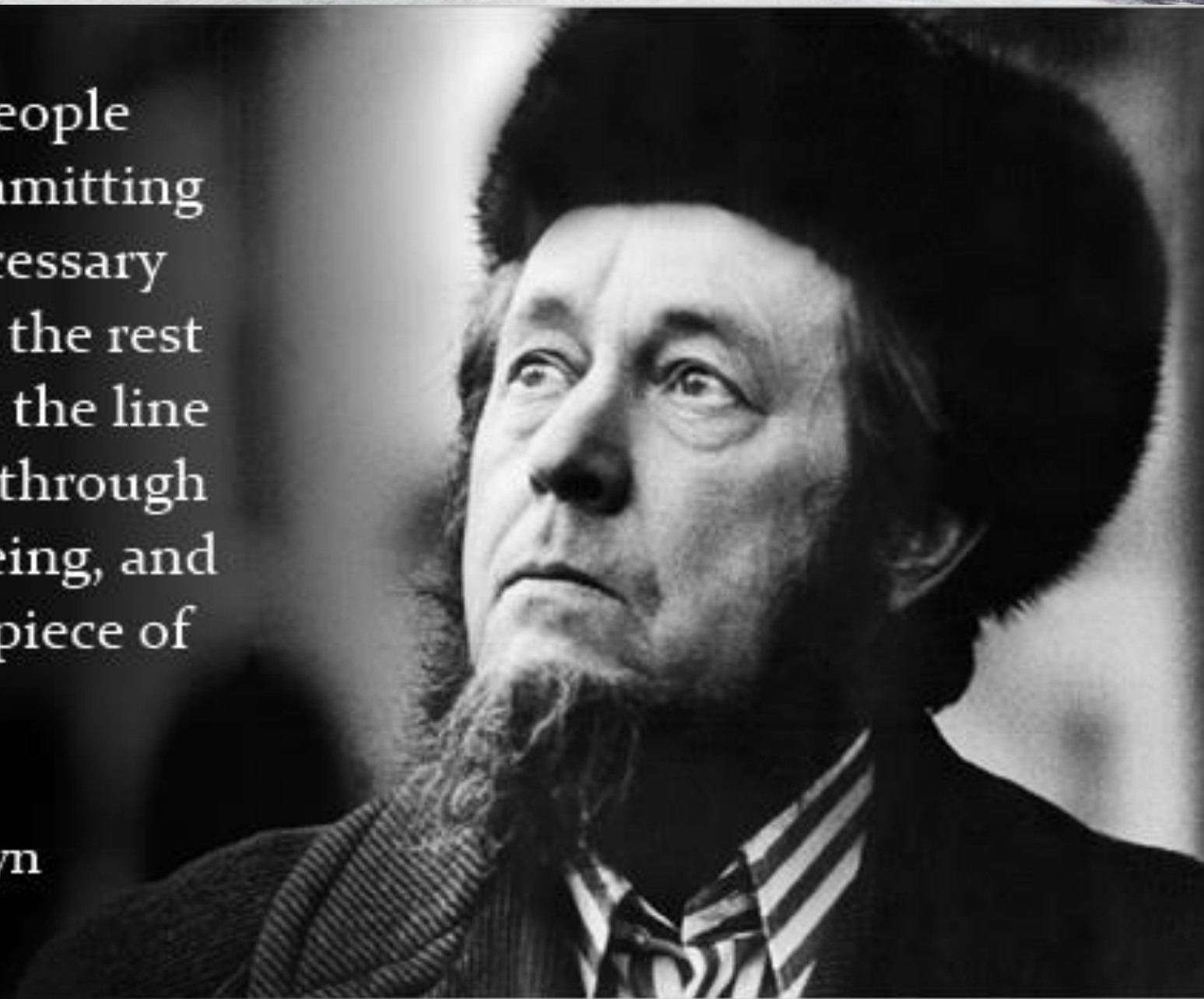

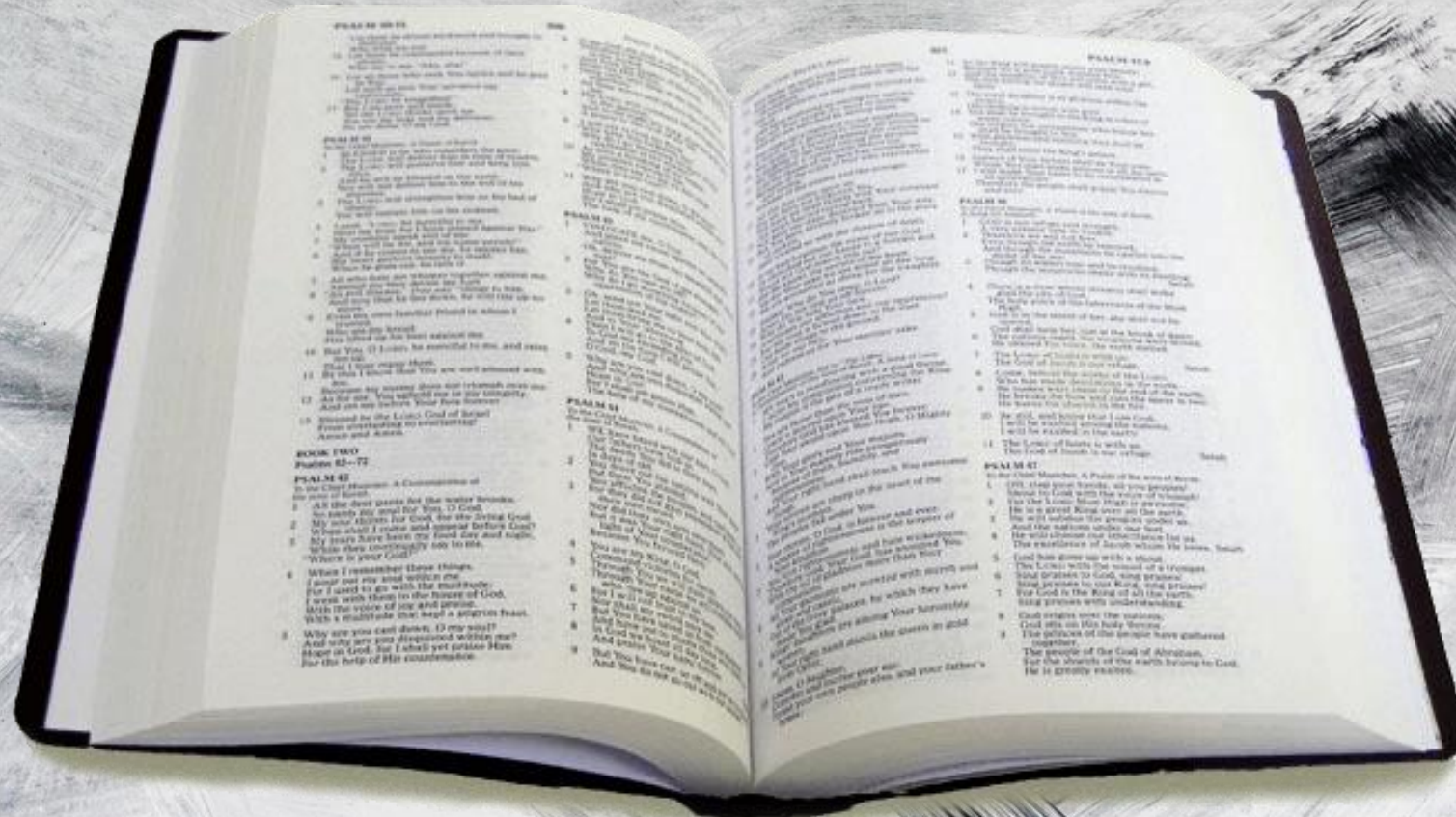
