Modules for the first week are ready. Each plastic bag contains about 7 or 8 modules for each subject in each grade level. The picture at right shows these modules in each bag. Mind you, these are just modules for the first week! Teachers will distribute these to the students starting October 5. After a week, they will return to the villages, collect and check all the modules, and replace them again with another set of modules. Please pray for us! If this pandemic will continue for months or years, we will be producing mountain pile of modules!



Pictures below show our staff in the Aeta Children's Home (ACH) preparing food reliefs that they will be giving to each of our students. We have 120 students who enrolled for this school year. As mentioned previously, our mission are twofold – education and feeding the students in the villages. ACH team has just conducted feeding of the children in the villages last week as shown in the pictures below. They will be doing this weekly when the Distance Education Program will start on Oct. 5.
