Purpose of the Local, "Small C" Church

Rick Warren, in *The Purpose Driven Church*, states that "these purposes are Worship, Fellowship, Discipleship, Ministry, and Mission", and that they are derived from the Great Commandment (Matt. 22:37-40) and the Great Comission (Matt. 28:19-20).

Definition of the Purposes:

WORSHIP: Glorifying God through a variety of means. Worship is not limited to the Sunday morning Worship Center experience. It is not defined by musical style. Worship is a whole-life experience in which God is honored intentionally and purposefully by individuals and groups.

FELLOWSHIP: A connection to, and interaction with, the body of believers.

DISCIPLESHIP: Growing in the likeness and knowledge of one's teacher. A disciple is a "learner" in New Testament terminology.

MINISTRY: Service to individuals and within the church.

MISSION: Ministry done (generally) outside the local church body with the intent of leading people to faith in Christ.

Jesus replied: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments."

MATTHEW 22:37-40

TAKEAWAY

Evil will prevail without the church.

There are many different ways that the Bible speaks about the struggle between good and evil.

For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms. Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand.

EPHESIANS 6:12-13

Be alert and of sober mind. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour.

1 PETER 5:8

The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.

Luke's "Light" Passage

LUKE 8:16

To all of us, Jesus simply says, "You are the light of the world."

Let's Talk About It

- 1. Describe a time when you were a light.
- 2. What do you think of the premise that the world is dark because we are not shining?
- 3. As the light of the world, are we being too quiet?

Details about the Light

The CAUSE - Jesus describes himself as the One who lights a lamp.

The COST - The purpose of light is to shine, but there is no shining without burning.

The CONCRETENESS - Letting our light shine is no abstract thing. It involves concrete behavior.

The CONSEQUENCE - God is glorified when our light shines.

Turn on the lights! It's time to shine, or else it'll be over soon. Are you ready to shine? The Church is not just any light, the Church (by God's grace) is the only light there is at all. As a member of Christ's Body, the Church, what are you doing to shine?

Let's Talk About It

- 1. What do you do on a regular basis that allows Jesus to light your lamp?
- 2. Do you agree that there is a cost to being a light? What has it cost you?
- 3. What is one thing you can point to in your life that demonstrates that you are trying to be the light of Christ?
- 4. Describe a time that God was glorified by you being the light.

Summary

UNDERSTANDING UNITY

- 1. The Power of Unity is NOT Discovered by Uniformity
 - a. Unity in Christ and His church is **NOT** conformity, but diversity. b. Unity in Christ and His church is **NOT** sameness, but variety. That's proven by the fact that God gives us all different spiritual gifts.
- 2. The Power of Unity IS Discovered in Love
 - a. Love for Jesus.
 - b. Love for one another.

"A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another."

JOHN 13:34-35

ENEMIES OF UNITY

Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit.

PHILIPPIANS 2:3a

- 1. Selfish Ambition
- 2. Vain Conceit

ATTITUDE OF UNITY

Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others.

PHILIPPIANS 2:3b-4

TAKEAWAY
