Four prayers...

"God, You need to give me love, understanding, and forgiveness (because I don't have it on my own)."

"You have heard the law that says, 'Love your neighbor' and hate your enemy. But I say, love your enemies! Pray for those who persecute you!" - Jesus, Matthew 5:43-44

"You have heard the law that says the punishment must match the injury: 'An eye for an eye, and a tooth for a tooth.' But I say, do not resist an evil person! If someone slaps you on the right cheek, offer the other cheek also. If you are sued in court and your shirt is taken from you, give your coat, too. If a soldier demands that you carry his gear for a mile, carry it two miles." Matthew 5:38-41

"God, help me understand their background, life, and experiences."

"You know it is against our laws for a Jewish man to enter a Gentile home like this or to associate with you. But God has shown me that I should no longer think of anyone as impure or unclean." Acts 10:28

"God, help me to see everyone through Your eyes."
