Overcoming the Lie of Labels July 20-21,2019

If I were to describe myself in three words or phrases—what would those words be?

If I wear labels too long they stop describing my past and begin to determine my future.

When Jesus returned to Capernaum several days later, the news spread quickly that he was back home. Soon the house where he was staying was so packed with visitors that there was no more room, even outside the door. Some men came, bringing to him a paralytic, carried by four of them. Mark 2:1-3

They couldn't bring him to Jesus because of the crowd, so they dug a hole through the roof above his head. Then they lowered the man on his mat, right down in front of Jesus. When Jesus saw their faith, he said to the paralytic, "Son, your sins are forgiven." Mark 2:4-5

If anyone is in Christ they are a new creation. The old is gone, new things have come. 2 Corinthians 5:17

As for you, you were dead in your transgressions and sins. But because of his great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy, made us alive with Christ. Ephesians 2:1,5
