

"God Wants You to be Happy" September 27-28, 2019

God does not want me to pursue happiness. God wants me to pursue Him.

In Your presence is fullness of joy; In Your right hand there are pleasures forever. Psalm 16:11

#1 God does not want me happy when I do something wrong or stupid.

But just as he who called you is holy, so be holy in all you do; 1 Peter 1:15

#2 God doesn't want me happy when I'm basing my happiness on the things of the world.

Do not love this world nor the things it offers you for when you love the world, you do not have the love of the Father in you. 1 John 2:15

#3 God does not want me happy as much as He wants me BLESSED.
