# Jesus said we all must be born again

There was a man named Nicodemus, a Jewish religious leader who was a Pharisee. After dark one evening he came to speak with Jesus. "Teacher," he said, "we all know that God has sent you to teach us. Your miraculous signs are evidence that God is with you." John 3:1-2

Jesus said, "I tell you the truth, unless you are born again, you cannot see the Kingdom of God."

"How can a man be born when he is old?" Nicodemus asked. "Surely he cannot enter a second time into his mother's womb to be born!" "Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit gives birth to spirit." John 3:3-6
