"Blessed are the merciful, for they will receive mercy." -Jesus, Matthew 5:7

radical /'radək(ə)l/

Adjective (especially of change or action) relating to or affecting the fundamental nature of something; far-reaching or thorough

If Jesus isn't messing up my life then I'm doing Jesus wrong.

Mercy is a radically different response of care and compassion to others because of what God has done in my life.

"Therefore, the kingdom of heaven is like a king who wanted to settle accounts with his servants. As he began the settlement, a man who owed him thirty million dollars was brought to him..."
