- On a scale of 1-10, how frustrated are you right now?
- In what areas of your life do you feel like you only have 1 click?
- What would happen if that 1 click isn't enough to hold you?
- How have you been calling out to God? Do you feel like He's listening?

3 Clicks Richie was trusting in things that would easily be lost in a fire. His hope was built on things of the world that would not last. Where is your trust built currently? Will your trust objects last through a season of 1 click living?

John had lost hope when he could no longer see God working. How strong is your faith when you don't feel God is answering your prayers for help? What do you do when your trust in God sags?

Review the 4 statements under "when frustration take over" in the message notes. Which one seems easiest? Which one is harder for you? Which one is impossible during 1 click living?

Read Isaiah 42:16. In what ways do you feel blind now, walking down unfamiliar paths? Where are the dark & rough places for you?

What does it mean to you that God will lead, guide, bring light & make things smooth? Are these things figurative or literal?
