Now What? (How Would Jesus Vote? #3) 11/8/20

God is still in charge and He still knows what He's doing.

Daniel 2

For the Scripture tells Pharaoh: I raised you up for this reason so that I may display My power in you and that My name may be proclaimed in all the earth. Romans 9:17
