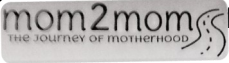

Bible Studies are starting up for the fall! Choose one and get plugged in!

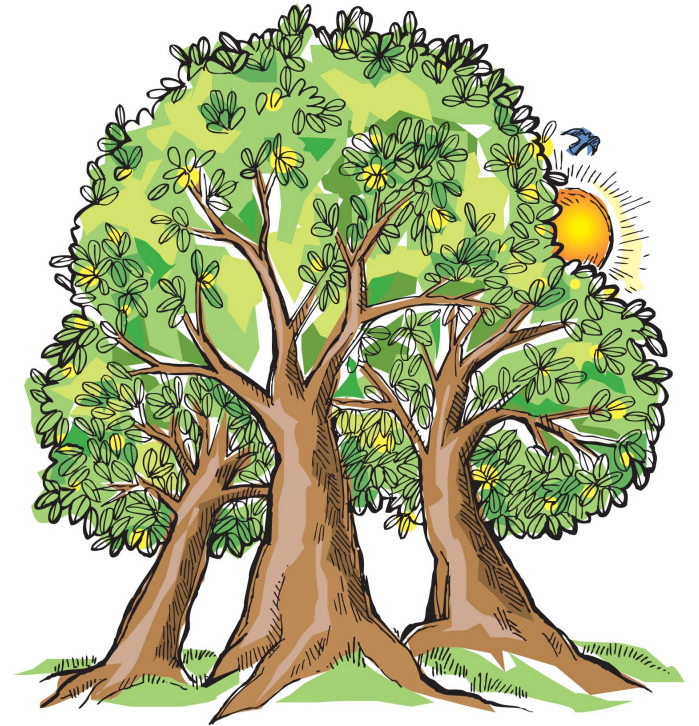
- ⇒ Wed., Sept. 4 - **Middle School Students** will meet before school at 7:45 a.m. at the school. Meeting every other Wednesday.
