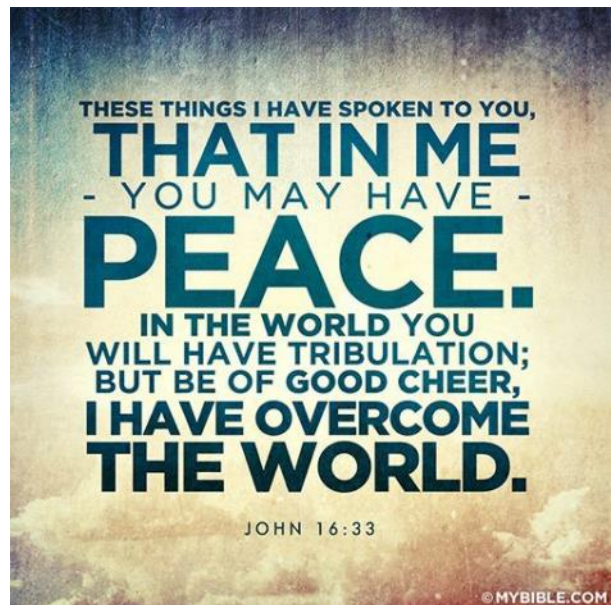
During these times of isolation, it can be difficult to find ways to be the hands and feet of Jesus. Here are some suggestions of how to show love to those around you:
