Jude 1:20 But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost,

- 1- **Romans 4:20** He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God;
- 2- **Proverbs 29:23** A man's pride shall bring him low: but honour shall uphold the humble in spirit.
- 3- **Ecclesiastes 10:2** A wise man's heart is at his right hand; but a fool's heart at his left.
- 4- **Proverbs 18:4** The words of a man's mouth are as deep waters, [and] the wellspring of wisdom [as] a flowing brook.
- 5- **Proverbs 12:14** A man shall be satisfied with good by the fruit of [his] mouth: and the recompence of a man's hands shall be rendered unto him.
- 6- **Proverbs 16:7** When a man's ways please the LORD, he maketh even his enemies to be at peace with him.
- 7- **Proverbs 18:16** A man's gift maketh room for him, and bringeth him before great men.
- 8- **Proverbs 27:9** Ointment and perfume rejoice the heart: so doth the sweetness of a man's friend by hearty counsel.
- 9- **Proverbs 13:8** The ransom of a man's life are his riches: but the poor heareth not rebuke.
- 10 – **Ecclesiastes 8:1** Who is as the wise man? and who knoweth the interpretation of a thing? a man's wisdom maketh his face to shine, and the boldness of his face shall be changed.
- 11 – **Matthew 10:36** And a man's foes shall be they of his own household.
- 12 - **Joshua 1:9** Have not I commanded thee? Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed: for the LORD thy God is with thee whithersoever thou goest.
- 13 - **Proverbs 28:1** he wicked flee when no man pursueth: but the righteous are bold as a lion.

- 14 - Isaiah 41:10** Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness.
- 15 – Psalm 75:1** Unto thee, O God, do we give thanks, unto thee do we give thanks: for that thy name is near thy wondrous works declare.
- 16 - Revelation 4:11** Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honour and power: for thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created.
- 17 - Pro 28:26** He that trusteth in his own heart is a fool: but whoso walketh wisely, he shall be delivered.
- 18 - 1 Peter 2:11** Dearly beloved, I beseech you as strangers and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts, which war against the soul;
- 19 – 2 Timothy 2:15** Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.
- 20 – 1 Timothy 1:17** Now unto the King eternal, immortal, invisible, the only wise God, be honour and glory for ever and ever. Amen.
- 21 – 1 Corinthians 10:10** Neither murmur ye, as some of them also murmured, and were destroyed of the destroyer.
- 22 – Acts 17:28** For in him we live, and move, and have our being; as certain also of your own poets have said, For we are also his offspring.
- 23 – 1 Corinthians 3:9** For we are labourers together with God: ye are God's husbandry, ye are God's building.
- 24 - Psalm 20:7** Some trust in chariots, and some in horses: but we will remember the name of the LORD our God.
- 25 – 2 Timothy 4:3** For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears;
